THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE PICKED UP

- 1. WHITE GOODS (WITH COMPRESSOR REMOVED)
- 2. LIMBS THAT ARE NO LONGER THAN 6 FEET
- 3. GRASS CLIPPINGS
- 4. CARDBOARD
- 5. FURNITURE
- 6. TOYS
- 7. APPLIANCES
- 8. LAWNMOWERS, TRIMMERS, ETC.
- 9. SMALL AMOUNTS OF CONSTRUCTION WASTE (IF CONSTRUCTION WAS DONE BY PROPERTY RESIDENT)
- 10. RESIDENTIAL WASTE ONLY---NO COMMERCIAL WASTE

ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE REMOVED

- 1. TIRES
- 2. BATTERIES
- 3. PAINT
- 4. CHEMICALS
- 5. CONSTRUCTION WASTE
- 6. LIMBS THAT ARE LONGER THAN 6 FEET
- 7. ROOFING MATERIAL

ALL MATERIAL TO BE PICKED UP SHOULD BE ON CURB IN FRONT OF HOUSE ON THE NORMAL DAY OF PICKUP FOR RESIDENT

ALL MATERIAL TO BE REMOVED MUST BE IN SEPARATE PILES ACCORDING TO TYPE OF WASTE

ALL LIMBS IN ONE PILE ALL FURNITURE IN ONE PILE ALL GRASS CLIPPINGS IN ONE PILE ETC.

CONTRACTORS OR REPAIR PERSONNEL SHOULD REMOVE ALL OF THE WASTE FROM EACH JOB. THE CITY WILL NOT PICKUP WASTE FROM CONTRACT OR PAID REPAIR PERSONNEL

THE CITY WILL ACCEPT CONTRACTOR AND REPAIR PERSONNEL TRASH AT THE CITY SHOP FOR A \$10.00 PER YARD DISPOSAL FEE IF THE WASTE WAS GENERATED IN THE CITY LIMITS.

IF A NATURAL DISASTER OCCURS THE CITY WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO REMOVE ALL WASTE RESULTING FROM THE DISASTER. (TORNADO, ICE STORM, HIGH WINDS, ETC.)
