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CHAPTER 12.04

PARKS COMMISSION

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<u>12.04.01 Established</u> There is hereby created and established the Wynne Parks and Recreation Commission. (Ord. No. 378, Sec. 1)

12.04.02 Membership That pursuant to the provisions of A.C.A. 14-269-202(e)(1) and (2), the membership of the Wynne Parks and Recreation Commission is hereby increased from five to seven members. (Ord. No. 535, Sec. 1.)

12.04.03 Appointed. The Commissioners shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by a majority vote of the duly elected and qualified members of the City Council, and shall hold office for a term of five (5) years; provided, however, that the commissioners first appointed and confirmed shall serve for terms of one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) years each to be designated by the Mayor and City Council, and thereafter appointed by the Mayor and approved by the majority vote of the City Council. (Ord. No. 378, Sec. 3)

12.04.04 Requirements for membership Section two (2) of Ord. No. 378 is hereby and hereafter amended to remove the requirement that commissioners appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Council be residents of Wynne. Hereafter such nominations and appointments may be made of qualified citizens and electors of Cross County, Arkansas. (Ord. No. 597, Sec. 1.)

- <u>12.04.05 Vacancies</u>. In the event of a vacancy-occurring on the Commission, it shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to the approval of a majority of the duly elected and qualified member of the City Council. Each commissioner shall sign the oath required by law in the State of Arkansas of public officials. (Ord. No. 378, Sec. 4)
- <u>12.04.06 Powers</u>. The Commission shall be vested with all the authority, and subject to all of the limitations prescribed by Arkansas Statutes. (Ord. No. 378, Sec. 5)
- <u>12.04.07 Rules and regulations</u> The commissioners shall adopt such rules and regulations as may be necessary and expedient for the proper operation and management of municipal parks and recreation programs and shall have authority to alter, change and amend such rules and regulations at their discretion. (Ord. No. 378, Sec. 6.)
