CLASS THREE GARBAGE REGULATIONS

The following items *will* be picked up:

- White goods (with compressor removed)
- Limbs no longer than six feet
- Bagged grass clippings
- Cardboard
- Furniture
- Toys
- Appliances
- Lawnmowers, trimmers, etc...
- Small amounts of construction waste (if construction was completed by the property owner)
- Residential waste only, no commercial waste

All material to be picked up should be placed at the curb in front of the house on the normal garbage pick-up day. Material to be removed must be sorted into piles based on the type of waste. For example:

- All furniture in one pile
- All bagged grass clippings in one pie
- All limbs in one pile

The following items *will not* be picked up:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Paint
- Chemicals
- Construction waste*
- Limbs longer than six feet
- Roofing material
- Unbagged grass clippings

*Contractors/repair personnel are responsible for removing the waste from each job.

*The city will accept contractor/repair personnel waste at the city shop for a \$15.00/yard disposal fee if the waste was generated inside the city limits.

In the event of a natural disaster, the city will make every effort to remove waste resulting from the disaster.
